Responsible Pet Ownership

Keep Up With Preventatives

Flea, tick, and heartworm preventatives are important aspects of keeping your pet healthy. Don't forget an annual fecal test as well. Most preventatives are administered monthly either orally or topically, so if you're running low on doses, now is the time to contact your veterinarian or purchase more from your local pet store.

Schedule an Annual Wellness Exam

Your pet should visit the veterinarian at least once a year for an annual exam, vaccines, and an overall wellness check. If your pet is 8 years or older, you may want to consider biannual visits to keep that extra eye on their overall health. If your pet is overdue for their annual visit, call your vet today to schedule an appointment. As a friendly reminder, All American Pet Resorts Rochester Hills requires that your pet be up-to-date on vaccines before entering the pet resort! Don't forget to provide us with all updated vaccination records.

Provide Proper Exercise & Diet

Winter can be a tough time to get your pet outside on a regular basis, but it's important to ensure that they are receiving adequate exercise and are also being fed a balanced diet. Walks or jogs, trips to the dog park, and a fun game of fetch are all great ways to exercise your pet.
